



RULES FOR THE TSCC SPORTING CHAMPIONSHIP

These rules are intended to encourage maximum participation in the Club's Sporting Championship for all members who either compete or officiate at a motorsport event.

The point score system is designed to recognise both participation and achievement of members in club level motorsport.

EVENTS CALENDAR:

Members who participate or officiate in club level competition events are encouraged submit their results and/or evidence of officiating for a maximum of their best 8 events for the calendar year to the Point Score Secretary, for inclusion in the Sporting Championship.

Members are responsible for advising the Sporting Secretary and the Point Score Secretary of their results and/or participation, for inclusion in the Sporting Championship.

ELIGIBILITY:

Only financial Members of TSCC who participate in CAMS sanctioned or other similar competition events approved by the Club e.g. CRC and GEAR are eligible for inclusion in the Sporting Championship.

Note: Members who compete in two or more cars and/or officiate at an event can only have one result or attendance per event counted towards the Sporting Championship.

POINT SCORE SYSTEM:

Competitors will be allocated points for each event as follows:

- Competing: 3 points
- Place in class: first place receives the number of points equal to the number of entrants (n) in the class, 2nd n-1, 3rd n-2 and so on e.g. in a class of 10: first receives 10 points, 2nd 9, 3rd 8 ... 10th 1
- Fastest Time of the Day (FTD): 3 points
- New Class Record: 3 points
- Entering under TSCC: 1 point

Note: For clarification, points allocated for the above dot points are added together to arrive at the total number of competition points per event.

Officials will be allocated 2 points for each event in which they officiate with a combined total of 8 events including driving/competing.

REPORTING PROCEDURE:

Whenever you compete or officiate in an event, please supply the following information on the TSCC Sporting Championship Report form:

- your name;
- event details (Date, Location etc.);
- whether you competed or officiated;
- your position and number of competitors in class or officiating position/role;
- the car you entered;
- whether you achieved the FTD;
- whether you achieved a new class record
- whether you entered as a TSCC member; and
- a few lines or more if you like about the event and how you went (as well as any photos or a YouTube link etc. if available), so that it can be incorporated in “Top Gear” and my report to the monthly meeting.

Members are responsible for advising the Sporting Secretary and Point Score Secretary of their results and/or participation for inclusion in the Sporting Championship.
