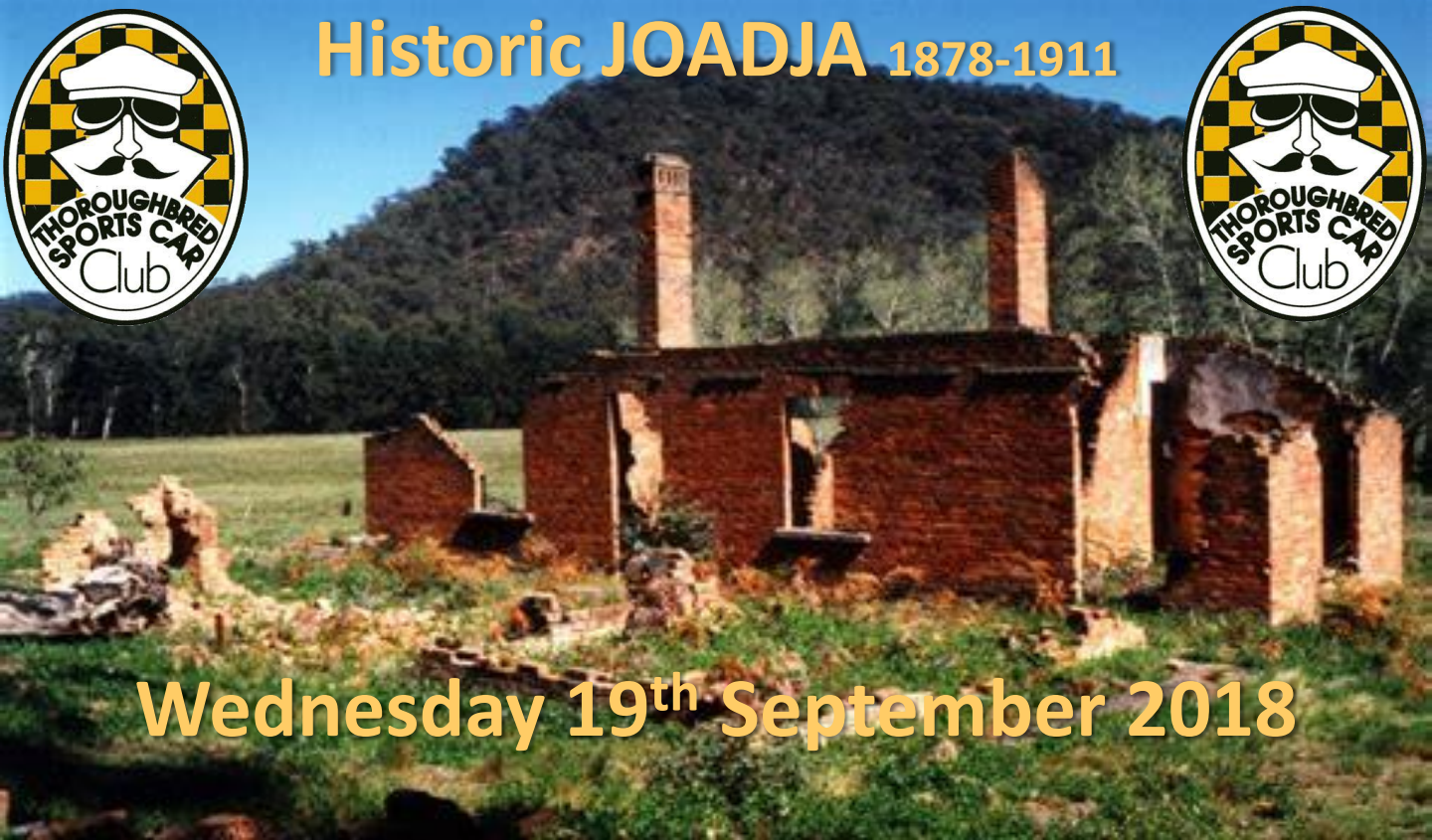




# Historic JOADJA 1878-1911

### Tour of Joadja Historic Town and Distillery

Joadja was a kerosene shale mining town which operated from 1878 to 1911 under the management of The Australian Kerosene Oil and Mineral Co.

After the collapse of the industry, the town was sold in 1911 and its people left the valley. Today, we can explore this bygone era and the natural beauty of this hauntingly magical place near Mittagong.
